Report of One Day Student-Led Visual Seminar Report

One day -Student Led Visual Art Seminar 2022-23

Student Led Visual Art Seminar was organized on 31st January 2023 at PGSR , Pune from 10.00am to 5.30pm

For the inaugural function Alumni Dr.Sruti Nigudkar was invited as Chief guest. Dr.Shetal More ,Campus In-charge graced the occasion. Dr.Vikram Kulkarni sir explained the purpose of organizing this seminar. Dr.More madam welcomed the Chief Guest. There were three sessions in total.

The first session was chaired by Dr.Sruti Nigudkar. Two parallel sessions were conducted next chaired by Dr.Vikram Kulkarni and Dr.Rajetri kulkarni.

The third session was chaired by Dr.Gauri Kate who is alumni and recipient of Tagore fellowship. She concluded the seminar after the sessions.

Dr.Vikram Kulkarni sir gave vote of thanks.

There were 25 entries from Pune ,Mumbai and Nashik-UG, PG and Ph.D students out of them 19 students presented their research papers in an off line mode at PGSR Drawing and Painting department ,Pune.

From the feed back received following are the findings :-

1. Out of the research papers 70% students presented in Marathi medium,20%in English medium and 10% in Hindi medium.
2. 90 % students were presenting research paper for the first time.
3. 100% students found this seminar useful for their research work.
4. 90% students found this opportunity enhancing their presentation skills.
5. 80 % student says that their understanding of research has improved through the seminar.
6. 70% students responded positively for the improvement in their knowledge about research.
7. 90% students are willing to participate in future for further activities in research.

This activity was organized by UG and PG department, Pune for the first time. The success of this activity is reflecting in students responses. The seminar was focused on enhancing their research orientation and skills.
