### **Report of National Seminar on New NAAC Accreditation Process- Roadmap for Higher Educational Institutions held on 16 and 17 February, 2018.**

National seminar on New NAAC Accreditation Process-Roadmap for Higher Educational Institutions was organised by SNDT Arts and Commerce College for Women, Pune in association with Centre for Educational Department Administration., Pune (CEDA) during Feb, 16 and 17, 2018.

The objectives of the seminar were

- i) To identify and understand issues and challenges in front of the colleges and IQACs with reference to selected areas of new NAAC accreditation
- ii) To provide a forum for experts, academicians and practitioners to discuss quality initiatives
- iii) To provide a platform to propose various strategies which would enhance the quality movement of NAAC accreditation

On 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 the seminar was inaugurated at the auspicious hands of Dr. Jagannath Patil, Adviser NAAC; Principal A.B. Deshpande and Hon. Vice Chancellor of SNDT WU Prof. Dr. Shashikala Vanjari. Principal Dr. A. B. Deshpande presented the theme of the seminar to the participants. Dr. Jagannath Patil, adviser NAAC presented key note address on New NAAC Accreditation Process. Principal A. B. Deshpande and Dr. Varsha Deshpande presented overview of the QIF of NAAC. Dr. B. D. Bhole spoke on benchmarking through institutional values and best practices. Principal Beena Inamdar gave inputs on innovations in teaching learning.

On the next day i.e.17<sup>th</sup> February 2018, Dr. A. G. Gosavi explained the need and aspects of Academic and Administration Audit. Dr. Rajendra Kharul gave detailed account of Green Audit. In the next session, Dr. Kharat spoke about Governance, Participative Leadership and Management.

Valedictory session was presided over by Dr. V. N. Magare- Pro Vice Chancellor of SNDT Women's University. The chief guest of the session, Dr. Nitin Karmarkar, Vice Chancellor of SPPU, emphasized on strengthening the IQACs of Higher education institutions in his speech.
